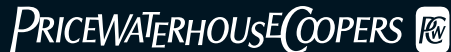
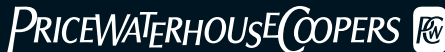

The judges will be looking for reporting which presents:

People Reporting

A balanced evaluation of the strength of human capital management and employment practice, both the breadth and quality of reporting will be taken into account including; description of the people strategy and how it relates to overall business performance; relevant and robust human capital data; and targets and / or benchmarks where appropriate.

Communication of Corporate Strategy

A clear explanation and quantification of your company's strategy; underpinned by a thorough description of the relevant resources and processes in place to support the stated strategy; including an assessment of the external factors affecting current and future performance.

Tax Reporting

The most transparent and understandable disclosure of corporate tax numbers, tax strategy and tax risk management policy, wider tax contribution (eg. employer related taxes) and economic impact, and how tax fits within the company's overall approach to corporate responsibility.

This new award recognises tax as a key factor in delivering shareholder value and managing reputational risk, and that companies' tax strategies and disclosures are coming under increasing scrutiny from shareholders, revenue authorities and wider public interest groups.

Reporting of Executive Remuneration

Information that reflects a manifest commitment to best practice and extends beyond the requirements of the legislation, provides an insight into the remuneration committee processes for setting and monitoring executive pay and demonstrates how the rewards accruing to executives are linked to the value built for shareholders.

Reporting of Economic Performance

Clear communication of the economic capital employed by the business and the economic return achieved in comparison to the cost of debt and equity financing, together with evidence that demonstrates externally that management clearly reports on business and financial issues that will affect economic value, enabling the reader to understand the financial wealth created or destroyed by the company.

The three pillars of reporting excellence: Content - a holistic picture of management's view of the business, relevant to both members and stakeholders, mirroring best practice recommendations made in the ASB's Reporting Statement; Quality - a forward looking narrative supported by quantified data, targets, benchmarking, and key performance indicators; and Linkage - accessible reporting, well structured and non repetitive, with a common voice running throughout.
